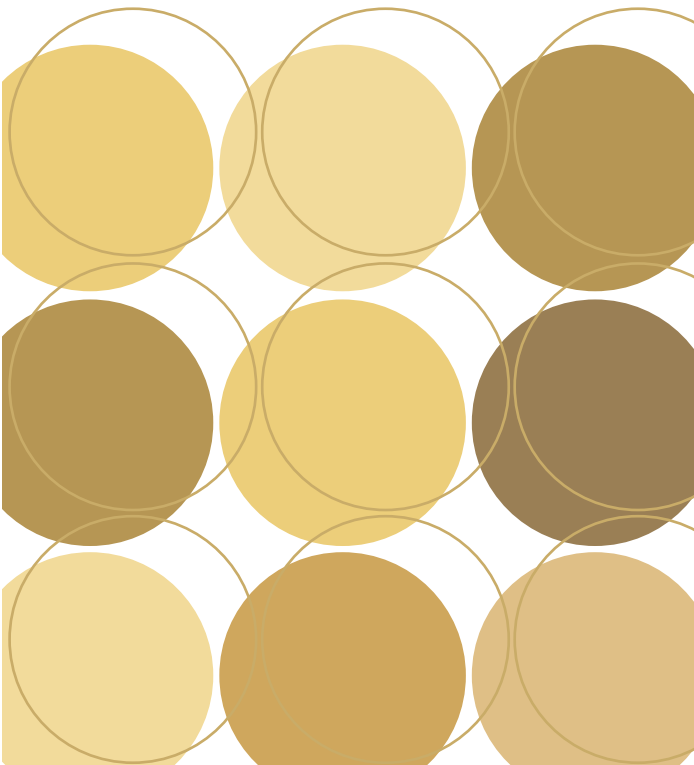


MISSION
